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Cadra Keylok USB Dongle Installation Instructions

Cadra began support of Keylok dongles with the 2004 release. However, support for Keylok dongles can be added to Cadra 2003 using the supplemental Cadra Keylok Dongle Support kit. (Note that USB dongles are not supported on Windows NT).

Installing Cadra Software and the Keylok USB Dongle

When installing Cadra with the Keylok USB Dongle it is necessary that the dongle **NOT** be installed prior to Cadra software installation.

Proceed with the Cadra Installation as follows:

1. Install Cadra **WITHOUT** the Keylok Dongle installed
2. Exit the Cadra software installation without installing the Product Authorization License

Installing the Keylok driver:

1. Bring up a DOS window and set your directory to the one containing the Keylok dongle driver files (in the drivers\keylok subdirectory after a Cadra installation).
2. For the USB dongle installation ensure that the dongle is **NOT** plugged in and execute the following command: **install /B**. Plug in the dongle after the installation is complete.

Now insert the Keylok USB dongle. Once the dongle has been installed, the operating system "Found New Hardware Wizard" window will be displayed.

1. At the "Welcome to the Found New Hardware Wizard" screen, Select the NEXT button to continue.
2. Agree to the automatical installation.
3. At the "Completing the Found New Hardware Wizard" screen, Select the FINISH button.

Once you have completed the above instructions, You may begin using Cadra.
